Pederson, Lawrence (Jan. 15, 1916 – Jan. 29, 2009)

Lawrence Pederson was born to Peter Andreas and Alice Margaret Pederson. The Pederson's were immigrants from Norway and had a homestead near Elbow, SK. Pederson attended Harley school, a one-room schoolhouse close to the Pederson farm. He married Alberta Viola, November 6, 1960, and together they pursued farming, until Alberta's death in 1989. Pederson moved into Chez Nous Senior Citizens home shortly thereafter, where he began to create his woodworking art.

Peter Pederson was a blacksmith and mechanic, and Lawrence learned much from him. His art is small wood and metal sculptures of mostly farm machinery and animals. He also does specialty pieces like wall hangings for his door and homemade Valentine's for Valentine's Day.
