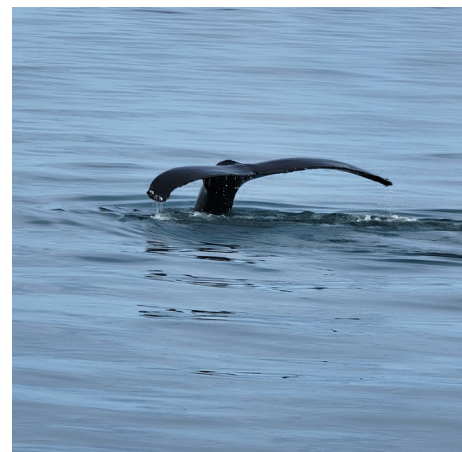

**Katherine Boyer:**  
*How the Sky Carries the Sun*  
September 22 - December 31, 2023

*How the Sky Carries the Sun* is a universe that extends beyond the artist's complex and seemingly dichotomous identity (Métis and white Settler). This exhibition explores Boyer's internalized dualities, expressed as the relationship between the sun and the sky. Boyer uses the exhibition title as an invisible through-line for structural support to explore the edges of a Queer, Métis phenomenology, that helps the artist ask "Am I the sky or am I the sun?", an important question about disorganized experiences and self-consciousness. *How the Sky Carries the Sun* presents installation-based work that allows Boyer to rotate between process and materials: traditional beading suspended on free-standing, wooden structures, cyanotypes depicting garden plants, lightboxes that use quilting but act as trusses, and knots that close obsessive cycles of labour.

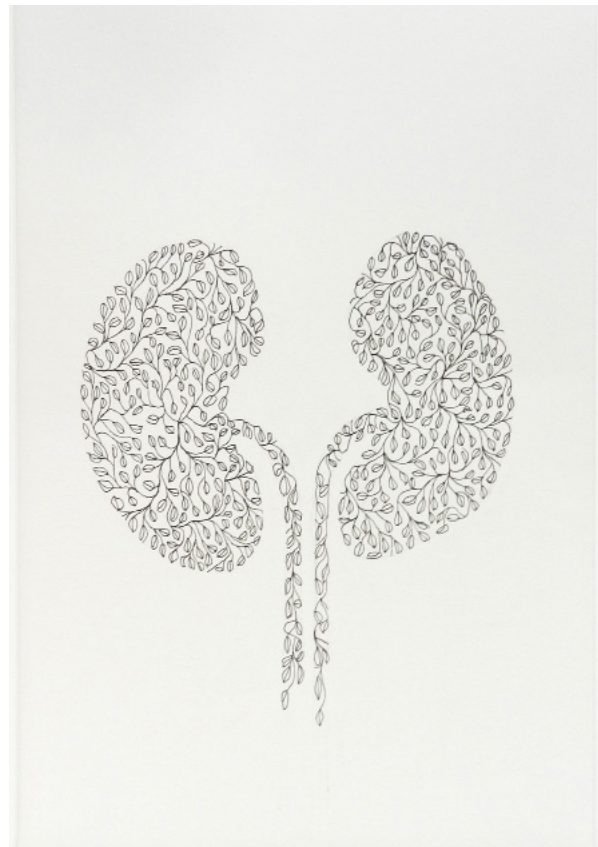

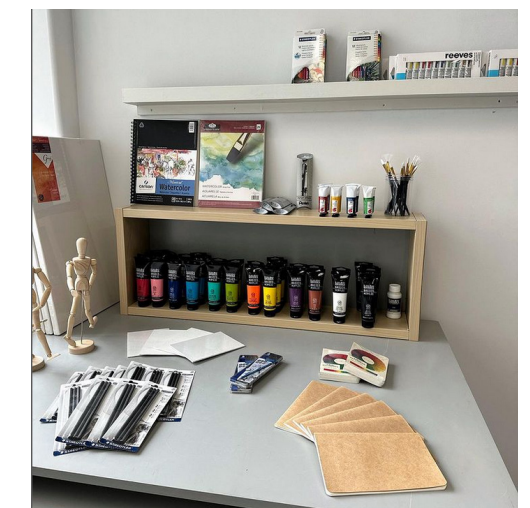
