

For the latest session of the Artbook Club, as a tiein for Fire in the Belly: Saskatchewan Women Artists from the MJM&AG Collection, we will be reading Ninth Street Women: Lee Krasner, Elaine de Kooning, Grace Hartigan, Joan Mitchell, and Helen Frankenthaler: Five Painters and the Movement That Changed Modern Art by Mary Gabriel.
